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Grade 8/9 Hockey Academy Application 2023/2024

Dear Parents/Guardians & Student-Athletes:

Dr. Kearney Middle School's Hockey Academy is currently accepting applications for the 2023/2024 school year. Our skills-based program provides students the opportunity to develop their basic hockey skills through on and off ice instruction. We focus primarily on individual skills such as skating, puck handling, shooting, and passing. In addition, an emphasis is placed on small-area games and team tactics within these games.

Currently, the schedule for the program is as follows:

September - April:

- **Mondays:** Off-ice training & Games in the Dr. Kearney Gym/Mini-Gym/Outside
- **Tuesdays & Thursdays:** On-ice skill development (1:15-3:00 at the arena)

May - June:

- **Monday's:** Off-ice training & Games in the Dr. Kearney Gym/Mini-Gym/Outside
- **Tuesday's & Thursday's:** Off-ice training at Goodlife Fitness (1:15-3:00)

Who is eligible?

- Grade 8 and 9 students

Selection:

- Interested students must complete the **APPLICATION AND QUESTIONNAIRE**, and return it to the school office by no later than **APRIL 30, 2023**. *We will accept emailed applications and questionnaires as long as they are signed by both the student and a parent/guardian.*
- Due to high demand, a selection process will take place. An in-person interview may take place as well.
 1. **Application:** Students will fill out the application form.
 2. **Questionnaire:** Students will complete the questionnaire **in detail**.
 3. **Selection:** The hockey academy instructors and school administration will have the final say on who is selected into the program.

Rules:

- The Hockey Academy program is a **privilege**, not a right.
- Behaviour and Grades are an integral piece of the program.
- The program works on a 3-Strike Basis. 3 strikes and a student is removed from the academy.
 - Example of strikes could include, but are not limited to:
 - Failing a course
 - Defiance/Behaviour issues at school
 - Suspensions
 - Etc.

Other:

- All players are responsible for providing their own hockey equipment.
- Students may be removed from the program if they are not meeting the academic and behavioral expectations of the school.
- **There is a fee of \$350 for our program.** This is used to cover the costs of our academy. Costs include ice times, bussing, gym memberships, jerseys, hoodies, etc. All funds will be collected after students have been selected.
- Students will receive approximately 50-60 on-ice sessions, 30-40 off-ice sessions, and 15-20 GoodLife gym sessions.
- If any player is unable to afford the program fee they can apply for a bursary to cover part of their enrollment. To apply, contact our school principal.
- If selected into the academy, students will be placed into one of 2 groups. These groups are decided by the instructors. Again, no one is being forced to participate in the hockey academy.
- Students will be bussed to the arena from Dr. Kearney at the end of Lunch. At the end of the school day, students will then have the option to be picked up from the arena by their parents or be bussed back to Dr. Kearney.
